FACT: It was NOT illegal to
consume alcohol, wine or
beer during Prohibition

Interestingly, the 18th Amendment only forbade the 'manufacture, sale and transportation of intoxicating liquors,' not their consumption. By law, any wine, beer or spirit Americans had stashed away in January 1920 were theirs to keep and enjoy in the privacy of their homes. For most, this amounted to only a few bottles, but some affluent drinkers built cavernous wine cellars and even bought out whole liquor store inventories to ensure they had healthy stockpiles of legal hooch.

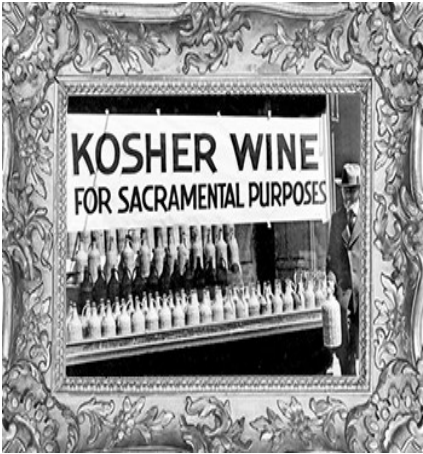
Over 141 Million Bottles of Wine Sold Before Prohibition!

Leading up to the passing of Prohibition, many of the great wineries of the time including Greystone, Brun, Chaix and De Turk concentrated on selling off their stocks through the California Wine Alliance. The endeavour would sell off more than 50 million gallons of wine.



Women's Temperance Movement

This group of advocating women was an instrumental factor that led to the 18th Amendment, A.K.A. Prohibition, which prohibited the manufacturing, selling, transporting, importing, and exporting of alcoholic beverages. Irony was not lost on the photograph below; no men wanted to or were willing to kiss these women.

America's Smoothest Cigarette

Old Gold Cigarettes were one of the most popular cigarette brands in America during the Roaring '20s. Introduced in 1926, Old Gold utilized many aggressive marketing tactics, including massive advertising campaigns and a syndicated comic strip that appeared in hundreds of newspapers across the United States. Babe Ruth was their most famous pitchman, appearing on an Old Gold poster while wearing his pinstriped Yankee whites.



U.S. Prohibition Agents intercept northbound train hiding illegal Whiskey

Atlanta, Ga.- U.S. prohibition agents intercepted a freight train traveling from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. to Chicago, Ill. masking a shipment of liquor as vegetables. Inside the train cars, behind a few crates of string beans and potatoes, prohibition agents found crates of pint-size bottles of whiskey, several thousand in number, piled five deep. A telegram from Fort Lauderdale tipped the federal men that the car was coming through Atlanta. Three squads of prison inmates, wearing striped prison gear and ankle chains, were tasked to break up the bottles with sledgehammers in front of onlookers; some who cheered, some who wept.
