Spiced Strawberry Mule \$13

Strawberry infused Absolut Elyx vodka with spiced ginger beer.

New York Sour \$14

Popular in Prohibition, try our Jameson Irish whiskey sour topped with a red wine float.

The Blind Tiger \$14

An original term for a Speak Easy. This refresher's made with Wigle's Ginever, Luxardo Maraschino, Pimms Blackberry Elderflower, and a cucumber garnish.

The Last Word \$14

Also a popular prohibition era cocktail. Developed at the Detroit Athletic Club, made here with Nolet's, Maraschino, green chartreuse, and lime juice.

The Graham \$14

James E. Pepper Rye infused with coco and mixed with agave nectar, lemon juice, and walnut bitters.

Scoff Law \$15

Feeling like a rule breaker? Have a Bulleit Bourbon, dry vermouth, fresh lemon juice, green Chartreuse, and orange bitters.

The Grammy \$14

A Graham invented Martini of Russian Standard, Maui Blanc, & a splash of Dolin dry vermouth finished with a burnt orange peel.

Mabel's Martini \$14

Our tribute to Alexander Graham Bells wife of 45 years. A citrus cocktail made with Campari and Domain de Canton.

The Dead Hooper \$15

Two left feet? Allow us to assist, made with dark rum, honey, lime, egg whites, angostura bitters, orange peel.

Smoked Sling \$15

D'ussé, Hickory Smoke and Cinnamon & cardamom bitters.

Old Fashioned

Our favorite classic whiskey cocktail with sugar, bitters, orange, and a cherry. The old-fashioned, because of its elasticity is at once, the “manliest cocktail order” and “something your grandmother drank”. Work with our mixologist to make your interpretation of the old classic.

FLIGHTS: A Trio of 1oz Pours

Glenlivet Flight: 12, 15, 18 **32**

Glenlivet is the oldest legal distillery in the parish of Glenlivet, the production place of the Scottish whisky. **12 year** Aroma: fruity and summery, Taste: well-balanced while still fruity with a pineapple taste, Finish: creamy, marzipan and hazelnuts. **15 year** Aroma: more buttery than 12, Taste: fruity, nutty flavors, Finish: sweet almonds and a hint of spice. **18 year** Aroma: rich, fruity aromas and toffee notes, Flavor: balanced with bursts of orange, Finish: long with spice and moist raisin notes.

Smokey Single Malts: **23** **Ardbeg 10, Clynelish 14,** **Balvenie 12, Ardbeg 10**

Aroma: Peat infused with zesty lemon and lime, Taste: Peat effervescences, black pepper, and smoke, Finish: long smoky, tarry espresso. **Clynelish 14** Aroma: candle wax and sugar, Taste: crisp, lingering, fresh fruity flavor Finish: salt, dry-ish, slightly bitter **Balvenie 12** Aroma: sweet fruit with Oloroso sherry notes, Taste: smooth, mellow, nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness, Finish: long and warming.

Flight of the Irish

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Jameson, Redbreast, Yellow Spot Jameson

Aroma: light and floral, Taste: balance of spicy, nutty, and vanilla notes.

Redbreast Aroma: complex, spicy, fruity, with toasted wood notes Taste: full flavored and complex, balance of creamy, fruity, Sherry toasted notes.

Yellow Spot Aroma: Mown hay and cracked black pepper, Taste: honey sweetness with pot still spices, flavors of fresh coffee and milk chocolate, Finish: Sophisticated and complex, with a mix of red grape and dry barley.

3 Barrels of Bulleit:

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10, Rye, Bourbon

Bulleit produces its whiskeys to be a beautiful amber color. **10 Yr** Aroma: rich oaky, with a vanilla dried fruit flavor, the 10 year aged barrels give a long smoky finish. **Rye** flavor has hints of honey, vanilla, and fruit Finish: crisp and clean, long lingering flavors.

Bulleit Bourbon a spirit that's subtlety and complexity come from its unique blend of rye, corn, and barley malt, with special strains of yeast and pure Kentucky limestone filtered water. Due to its especially high rye content it has a bold, spicy character, with a finish that's distinctively clean and smooth.

Off to see the Willets:

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**Pot still, Noah's Mill, and
a 2 year rye**

Willet Pot Still Aroma: floral & citrus
Taste: more citrus on the palate with
loads of honey, Finish: very herbal. (*An
incredibly different array of aromas & flavors when
water is added*), **Noah's Mill** Aroma: wood
and forests, Taste: strong flavors of
brown sugar, caramel, bourbon
smokiness, Finish: very warm without
unnecessary burn. **Willet 2 year Rye**,
Aroma: orange, licorice, and perfume
notes, Taste: mint, honey, and citrus
notes, Finish: more mint and herbal,
(*more floral with fruit notes when water is added*).
